

Appropriations

The budget process was very different in the expedited legislative session: no joint budget subcommittees, no individual budgets, no budget targets.

[HF2643](#) appropriates a status quo budget for the upcoming fiscal year, spending for agencies will remain at the same level as FY 2020 for most departments and agencies. The bill does provide increases for some programs:

- Requires the Department of Management, in consultation with the Legislative Services Agency, to determine the amount of state and federal appropriations made in FY 2020 and which entities received the money.
- Appropriates:
 - DAS Utilities — \$3.88 million
 - DOM — \$1.2 million
 - DOE Deaf School — \$10.5 million
 - Braille School — \$4.4 million
 - DHS FIP — \$5 million
 - Medicaid Reimbursement — \$1.5 million
 - Supplemental Assistance — \$7.35 million
 - S-CHIP — \$37.6 million
 - Glenwood — \$16.7 million; Woodward — \$10.9 million; Eldora \$16 million
 - Property Tax Credits (\$160.4 million)
- Effective on enactment. Makes provisions effective as of July 1, if signed after July 1. Contains corrective provisions.
